 Malapenny at the Sea side in Somerset County before W^m
 Stevens then and here Coroner Bonahandum being sent
 for by a Interpreter did appear with some of the great
 men, and upon examination did Confesse the substance
 of what is contained in John Severes deposition taken at
 the time of the aforesaid Inquisition whereupon the said
 Bonahandum is committed to the Sheriffe of Somerset
 County to be brought before His Excell^{ty} Justice at the next
 Provinciaall Court

John Severes acknowledges himselfe to be
 indebted to the R^t: Hon^{ble}: the Lord Proprietary
 Twenty pounds sterl: if he shall not appear
 at the next Provinciaall Co^{rt} before His Excell^{ty}
 Justice there to give in evidence against
 Bonahandum that is found by Inquisition to
 have killed John Berke
