

following Petition which is read, viz;

To the w^{or}ship^{ful} Comm^{rs} of Somerset County
The humble Petition of John Kibbler

Humbly sheweth

That whereas yo^r Peti^r had some Rogues of Tobacco lying
at the Tobacco house of John Harrison being w^{or} of John
Harrison, yo^r Peti^r did send Charles Perry and Thomas
Harrison on the 15th day of February in the year 1672
the Dominion of the R^{ts} Hon^{rs} Cecilius or Demog. J^ohnson 1672
unto the house of John Harrison to fetch the said Rogues
of Tobacco for yo^r Peti^r the said John Harrison on the 4th day
of the said month of February delivered the said Rogues
of Tobacco to the said Charles and Thomas who brought the said
Tobacco to yo^r Peti^r sloop then riding against the
Dipond Plantation, John Avery master of the sloop springing
one of the R^{ts} with caused the said Charles and Thomas to carry
the same on shore to the Landing of Stephen Lupton to Rouse it
