Elizabeth with all her female increase until she attaineth to
to the age of fourteen years And here To have curd to hold
both male and female and to enioyn and Dispose of all her proper
goods for ever, the said Cow and her increase to run in Assent
amongst my own for the use and benefit of my daughter aforesaid
until
