 the master of the ship to me the said 3 promise to
 give him his Condition in and clear him from all
 persons from the beginning of the world unto this day
 at witness my hand this 5th of June Thomas Swan

Thomas Swan appears before the board
 and reads the writing to be his & claims
 the said Christopher for his Service p^{ro}viding
 the following Articles of Agreement; /;

Articles of Agreement made concluded and agreed
 upon this 27th day of May A^o 1673 betwixt Christopher
 Snofball of the one party and Thomas Swan of the
 other party witnesseth that the abovesaid Christopher
 doth covenant promise and grant to and with the
 abovesaid Thomas to serve him in all such Service
 and Employments as he the said Thomas shall employ
 him in (making Allowance) from the day of
 the date hereof untill the 25th day of December
 next ensuing, And if it should soe happen &
 the said Snofball should be sick or lame or by
 any
