

Acquitt and Discharge the bearer Name of Christopher
Snoffall from any Service or debts or Bills or bonds upon
his account that he doth get discharge home to his
friends in the Hull Haven or otherwise to return home
again in six days to prosecute to John Henderson
Rough and there to stay by residue of his time but if
the said Christopher Snoffall delay being from under
the master of his ship to me thence day I promise to
give him his passage in and Please him from all
persons from his beginning of his world unto his day
as witness my hand the 6th of June Thomas Evans

Thomas Evans appears before the board
and swears he writing to the Recd & claiming
the said Christopher for his servant promising
the following articles of agreement; / /

Articles of Agreement made concluded and agreed
upon this 27th day of May 1673 between Christopher
Snoffall of the one party and Thomas Evans of the
other party witnesseth that the abovesaid Christopher
doth hereunto promise and grant to and with the
abovesaid Thomas to serve him in all his Service
and Employment as the said Thomas shall employ
him in (making due excepted) from the day of
this date henceforth until the 25th day of December
next ensuing, and if it should be Rotten &
the said seafarer should be sick or lame or his
service
