

The Deposition of John King of Manoaquin aged about  
25 years taken in County 12<sup>th</sup> August 1633

Saith

The last summer I was at Mr. Johnsons and it was said  
there was strange cows; And I went to see whether it was  
not my mothers she having lost a cow then; but it was  
none of hers, being an old brown cow cropt of the left ear  
and overhalled of the right ear, And I saw a cow at Mr.  
Revels pen of the same mark. Last summer & further said  
John King

Know all men by these presents that we Thomas Evans  
of Peromok in Sommersett County in the Province of Maryland  
Boatwright William Giles of the province aforesaid planter  
and George Theobis of the same County & Province aforesaid

Cooper doe stand and are firmly bound and obliged unto  
the Rt Hon<sup>ble</sup> Cecilius Absolute Lord and Proprietary  
of the Province of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of  
Baltimore &c in the summe of ten pounds Sterling money

To be paid to the said Lord Proprietary his Heires Heirs and  
Proprietaries or their certain Attorneys; To the which payment  
well and truly to be made we doe binde us and every and  
either of us Jointly and severally for and in the whole  
our and every and either of our Heires Executors and  
Administrators firmly by these presents sealed with  
our seals and signed with our hands dated the sixteenth

day of August in the 11<sup>th</sup> year of the Dominion  
of
