Whereas m^r: Henry Smith of this County made a
Proposition to the Commissioners of this County that if
they would give unto him all the Arrements that
are due from the severall persons left in here since in
this County Co^{ty} (as that should arrive due upon the
same Arrements till January Co^{ty} next following) according
to Act of Assembly that then he the said Henry Smith
would at his owne Cost and Charges at the Head of Bark
Creede at Manokin upon the plantation where Tho: Post
lately lived (and where the Co^{ty} for this County was formerly
kept) Cause to be made provided and set up a paire of
Storks and Drinking Stools and other things appointed by
Act of Assembly to be made and provided at the Charge
of the County for the punishing of offenders within
this County which Proposition was accepted of by the
Major part of the Comm^{rs} of this County whereupon
at a Co^{ty} held for this County in January last past it
was ordered that the Arrements aforesaid should be
paid to the said Henry Smith he being to provide what
