

Whereupon Charles Brien voluntarily in his proper person  
 appeared in C<sup>o</sup> and professed to pay to same, for the said  
 Daniell Panson, and Acknowledged Brien for one thousand  
 four hundred pounds of tobacco due from him the said Charles  
 Brien to be paid to Ambrose White with cost of suit And  
 thereupon he C<sup>o</sup> ord<sup>d</sup> the said Charles Brien to pay unto  
 Ambrose White or his ord. one thousand four hundred pound  
 of tobacco & cost of suite at the expiration  
 whereupon he said Ambrose White doth in open C<sup>o</sup> acquitt  
 & release the said Dan: Panson from any further service or  
 offer to same harmless and defendy said Dan: from paying  
 to any person or persons the summes of tobacco mentioned in  
 the Act brought here into C<sup>o</sup>

 the 20<sup>th</sup> day of July Annoy Domini 1672 by instrument  
 specially signed with the hand and sealed with the seals  
 of him the said Leonard Jones (with it produced here in C<sup>o</sup>)
