 be paid to the said Henry Smith or his Assignes now and in
 Consideration of his Charge and trouble about providing stocks
 and other things (appointed to be provided by Act
 of Assembly as aforesaid) as also of convenient Rents at the
 place aforesaid for the Commissioners of this County and others
 that have publique business to doe on any day there to meet
 and doe the same as also to keep the County Court there at the
 certain dayes appointed by Act of Assembly for the holding
 the same so long as the Comm^{rs} shall think fitt soe to doe; /

It is further ordered that the present Sheriffe and his heire
 have bin Sheriffes formerly have notice of this order that
 they pay the said Arrements to the said Henry Smith
 Accordingly
