Nicholas Fountain appears to the cause depending as sworn  
 The deposition of Nicholas Fountain aged forty years or  
 thereabouts deposes that he is Co<sup>l</sup>;

I say that day that neighbour Jervis did buy the woman ...  
 Jervis called over the creek for passage and the man ...  
 was with her mistress and her mistress examined her how long  
 she had to serve and she made answer four years; I saith  
 her mistress that is upon the promise if your master find your indentures  
 and severall dayes after I heard ... Lappage saith she had but  
 four years to serve which was upon Atina when he  
 called Thomas Davis and Phillip Morris and set them down  
 in his book ... saith and further saith not  
 Nicholas Fountain
