Sommeset^r for John Ellis late of this County was admitted
Answer unto Thomas Walker in d^{pl}ca of Debt that he
render one thousand three hundred eighty two pounds
of good sound merchantable pork which he oweth
and unv^{er}sally detemeth &c

And whereupon the said Thomas Walker for himselfe saith
that he the said John Ellis did the present year 1673
1673 by three certain specialties one one for four hundred
fifty nine pounds of pork another for eight hundred and
six pounds of pork and other other for one hundred and
seventeen pounds of pork which said three specialties
amount to in the whole to one thousand three hundred
eighty two pounds of pork and were signed with the hand &
sealed with the seale of him the said John Ellis (which is
produced here in C^o by the pl^t) Affirmed upon himselfe
and promise that he the said John Ellis would pay or cause
to be paid unto him the said Thomas Walker his heirs exors &
or assigns upon Demand the quantity of pork aforesaid to the
performance of which he the said John Ellis binds himselfe
his heirs exors & assigns and adu^{er}s but he the said John Ellis
regarding his promise and Affirmation fraudulently intending
to deceive him the said Thomas of the aforesaid quantity
of pork although often demanded yett never the less
