Thousand eight hundred and forty pounds
of tobacco and Cash as by his Specialty under
his hand and seal doth appear but the said
John fraudulently intending refuse to pay
unto the said John Barke the aforesaid Summe
of one thousand eight hundred and forty pounds
of tobacco and Cash whereupon the said John
is Damified and hath Damadge to the value
of Three Thousand pounds of tobacco and Cash and
thereupon brings his suite; /
