


his promise & title regarding but fraudulently intending

 The Court writing reads

Know all men by these presents that I W<sup>m</sup> Giles of  
 Mansfield in the County of Somerset in the Province of New  
 England planter to one and stand Justice indebted unto David Brown  
 of the County and Province aforesaid in the sum of fifty pounds  
 of four hundred twenty eight pounds of good tobacco and  
 Cash it being for valuable consideration by me for said  
 William received to be paid in some convenient place in  
 Mansfield or New England unto the said David Brown his heirs  
 executors or assigns at or before the feast of October next  
 ensuing the said sum of 50 £ w<sup>th</sup> payment well and truly  
 to be made I bind me my heirs executors administrators  
 jointly & severally together with the said William for the said sum  
 of 50 £ the 23<sup>th</sup> of August 1673; / W<sup>m</sup> Giles (seal)

W<sup>m</sup> Giles doth severally bind himself and seals with said writing  
 whereupon his Co<sup>ts</sup> orders that the said W<sup>m</sup> Giles pay unto the  
 said Plaintiff David Brown five hundred twenty eight  
 pounds of good tobacco & Cash w<sup>th</sup> Cost of such other expences / /
