The Deposition of Miles Gray Sworne

Saith I Miles Gray being used in the Marking of Colborne
Edmund Starburghs Cattle is now called to testifye the
Marke of the said Cattle which the Marke is (cept in
the left and overhalfe of the right which commonly
by mistake of Marking of Cattle they (cept the right
ear as well as the left and overhalfe the left as
well as the right

Sworne in Co. the 12th August 1673

And the same day to wit the 11th day of Sept: 1674
