Sommerzett<sup>s</sup> Amos Parsons of this County, Plaintiff  
 Summoned to Answer unto William Plummer  
 in Aplea of Trespass upon the Case & / /

And whereupon the said William Plummer for himself  
 saith That he the said Amos Parsons in the year of o<sup>r</sup>  
 Lord God one Thousand six hundred seventy and five  
 did take up of the said William severall goods and  
 merchantizes (as ff<sup>o</sup> An<sup>o</sup> here produced in Co<sup>ty</sup> do<sup>te</sup>  
 appear) to the value of one Thousand forty and one pounds  
 of Tobacco and Cash for the which goods he the said Amos  
 did Assume upon himselfe and promise to pay the  
 said William the year last past the said Summe of  
 one Thousand forty and one pounds of Tobacco in Cash. But  
 the said Amos failing of his promise and Assumption  
 paid the said William but seven hundred & fourteen  
 pounds of Tobacco; And now the said Amos fraudulently  
 intending to deceive him the said William of the  
 remainder of the s<sup>d</sup> An<sup>o</sup> which is the s<sup>d</sup> Summe or  
 quantity of three hundred twenty seven pounds of
