The p<sup>l</sup> and def<sup>t</sup> appeared in Co<sup>rt</sup>

John Anderson late of Somerset County was attached to answer Randall Revell in Appl<sup>n</sup> of Debt

And where upon the said Randall Revell for himself saith that the said John Anderson did upon the eight day of April in the year of the Dominion of Cecilus or St. J. 1671 by Act and specialty signed with the hand and sealed with the seals of him the said Anderson, with it produced by the p<sup>l</sup> in Co<sup>rt</sup> above upon himself and promise that he the said Anderson would pay or cause to be well and truly paid unto Randall Revell aforesaid his certain certain administrat<sup>or</sup> or assigns the full and just quantity of one thousand pounds of good sound merchantable tobacco and C<sup>ts</sup> to the said Randall Revell or his ord<sup>r</sup> upon all demands after the 10<sup>th</sup> day of October next ensuing the date of the said specialty at some convenient place in Somerset County to the performance of which he binds himself his heirs executors and assigns in the penalty of two thousand pounds of C<sup>ts</sup> tobacco

tobacco but he the said Anderson hath regarding his promise fraudulently intending to deceive him the said Revell of the aforesaid quantity of one thousand pounds of good sound merchantable tobacco & C<sup>ts</sup> which being often demanded but he the said Anderson denying and still duty to pay the p<sup>l</sup> saith he is dampified and hereupon brings his suit for the penal summe of two thousand pounds of tobacco

This bill was read

This bill binds me John Anderson of the Province of Maryland and County of Somerset Saith my certain administrat<sup>or</sup> or assigns to pay or cause to be well and truly paid to me Randall Revell of the Province aforesaid and High Sheriff of the said County his certain attorney his heirs executors or assigns the full quantity of one thousand pounds of good sound merchantable tobacco and C<sup>ts</sup> to be paid at some convenient place in Somerset County and due at all demands after the 10<sup>th</sup> day of October next ensuing for his true performance whereof I bind myself my heirs executors or assigns in the penalty of two thousand pounds of C<sup>ts</sup> tobacco as witness my hand and seal this 8<sup>th</sup> day of April St. J. 1671 ; /

John Anderson appeared and acknowledged due one thousand pounds of tobacco whereupon the Co<sup>rt</sup> ord<sup>r</sup> the said John Anderson to pay unto Randall Revell one thousand pounds of tobacco and C<sup>ts</sup> Charges otherwise expressed
