And the said Henry for himselfe suite that the said George became indebted unto the said Henry the summe of eighteene hundred pounds of Tobacco and Cashe as by his specialty more plainly may appear but the said George fraudulently intending refuseth to pay the aforesaid summe of eighteene hundred pounds of Tobacco & Cashe although thereunto severall times hath bin demanded whereby the said Henry is damaged and hath damage to the value of three thousand pounds of Tobacco and Cashe and thereupon brings his suite, / /

This bill bindeth the said George Day and his heirs executors to pay or cause to be paid unto Henry Smith his heirs executors or assigns the summe of eighteene hundred pounds of good sound tobacco and Cashe to lyeing in some convenient place

in the County of Somersett at or before the 20th of October
