This bill bindeth me William Broadwell of the County of Somerset
Shoemaker my selfe my heires executors administrators or
assignes to pay or cause to be paid unto George Howell of the
aforesaid County of the Province of Maryland his heires executors
or assignes or to his heire and Lawfull Attorney the full and true
quantity of three hundred and sixty pounds of good sound mar-
shantable tobacco and Cash to containe the same in being for a
valuable Consideration by me received in hand to paye unto George
Howell or his aforesaid order due to be paid at or upon the tenth of
November next ensuing the date hereof to be paid in some
convenient place in the County abovesaid my hand and seal this
Seaventh of October 1671
