Know all men by these presents that I Richard Pomfroy of Sommersett County in the Province of Maryland planter do owe and stand indebted unto Robert Catten of the County aforesaid in the Province of Maryland planter in the full & just Summe or quantity of foure hundred pounds of good sound merchantable Tobacco with Cashe the same to be paid to the said Robert Catten his heirs executors or certain Attorney at one entire payment in some convenient place in Annapolis in the County aforesaid at or before the tenth day of October next following the date hereof for the true performance whereof I binde my selfe my heirs executors & admors firmly by these presents signed with my hand and sealed with my Seale the second day of September Anno Domini one thousand six hundred Seventy & foure, /
