And whereupon the said Edmund Beauchamp for himself saith
 that he the said John Ellis did upon the 10th day of April in
 the 22nd year of the Dominion of Cecilius Anno Domini 1671
 by Martin specially signed with his hand and sealed with his seal
 of him the said John Ellis which is produced by the plaintiff. And
 in the Assize upon himself and promise to pay unto Edmund
 Beauchamp or his heirs at the plantation of the said John Ellis at or
 before the 10th day of December next ensuing the Debt of the said
 specially one hundred pounds of neat pork for the performance
 of which the said Ellis bindeth himself as his heirs executors and
 administrators. And afterwards upon Consideration of Ralph Jagers
 Sheriff due from the said Ellis to the said Beauchamp the said
 Beauchamp giving him or forbearing the said Ralph Jagers warrant by
 which the said Beauchamp did the said Ellis did further engage and
 promise to bring the said one hundred pounds of neat pork to the new
 dwelling house of the said Beauchamp but the said Ellis still regarding
 his assumption and promise but fraudulently intending to deceive
 him the said Beauchamp of the aforesaid quantity of pork which
 being demanded but he the said Ellis denying and still doth to pay
 and bring the same the plaintiff saith he is disappointed and
 hath demanded and hereupon brings his suit at
