 did put his hand to the said writing (which is produced in
 Court by the p^r but he the said John having neither by himselfe
 nor by any other way or means delivered such servant
 qualified as aforementioned to the said Thomas according
 to his engagement the p^r saith he is damaged and
 hath damage to the value of two thousand pounds of
