 And whereupon the said William by his Attorney Henry
 Smith saith That the said John became indebted unto
 him the said William in the first summe or quantity
 of four hundred and fourteene pounds of godd sound
 manerable tobacco in wch as per certaine writing
 here in Crv produced signed with the hand of him by
 said John will more plainly appear bearing date
 the 9th day of July Anno Domini 1674 wherein the
 said John did affirme upon himselfe and promise to pay
 unto the said William or his order the aforesaid quantity
 of 414^l of tobacco and Caste upon the 10th day of November
 next ensuing the date of the said writing And for the
 performance hereof he by said John bindes himselfe
 his Recds or assignts But he the said John fraudulently
 intending to defraude him by said William of the said
 quantity of 414^l of tobacco and Caste denying and still
 refuse to pay the same Althoough often thereunto required
 therby saith he it Damified and Recke Damaged to
 the value of 1000^l of tobacco in Castle and thereupon
 bringeth his suitth / / & our Hn: Justice
