Rec<sup>d</sup>: of 20<sup>th</sup> 1674

Rec<sup>d</sup>: of m<sup>r</sup> Henry Smith five hundred pounds  
 of tobacco w<sup>ch</sup> is due from m<sup>r</sup> W<sup>m</sup> Tompson  
 to me & say rec<sup>d</sup>: by me this 4<sup>th</sup> day of May 1674

And the Defendant W<sup>m</sup> Tompson on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of  
 March Annoy Domini 1674 appeared in his prop<sup>r</sup>  
 person & saith that he hath given by pl<sup>t</sup> Credit upon R. 6  
 Bill w<sup>ch</sup> is by pl<sup>t</sup> over to him for this five hundred pounds of tobacco  
 & therefore craves Answer: That w<sup>ch</sup> ord<sup>r</sup>: Inconform<sup>r</sup>
