By virtue of warrant bearing date the 6th day of April
 in the 43th year of the Dominion of his R^{ty} Hon^{ble} Charles
 the first Annoq; Domini 1675 Granted forty
 Laying out of fifty Acres of Land for the use of
 Somerset County Signed by his Hon^{ble} Steven^{ts} *[Signature]*
 order for these are therefore humbly to Certifie that
 I Francis Jourdain Deputy Surveyor under his Hon^{ble}
 Walter Brooke Esq^r Surveyor Gen^l have laid out
 for the use of Somerset County a parcel of Land
 called Glogester a fruitful Lying and being on the
 east side of Chesapeake Bay near the head of Manokin
 river about three miles back in the Woods from the
 said River bounded as follows beginning at a marked
 red oak standing on the South west side of a branch of
 Manokin river called Smiths branch thence with
 a line drawn west South west for 60 rods forty rods
 to a marked red oak standing by a branch side of the
 river
