The following bill was read, vizt;

This Bill binds me John Anderson my heirs executors  
 administrators or assigns to pay unto John Pitt his executors  
 or assigns the full Summe of six hundred seveny and  
 three pounds of good merchantable tobacco and Caske in  
 some convenient place in Satapult river at or upon the 10<sup>th</sup>  
 of October next ensuing after the date hereof as without any  
 Record this 30<sup>th</sup> of the 11<sup>th</sup> mo<sup>th</sup> called January 1664
