 day of June A<sup>o</sup> 1673 and was taken up the 18<sup>th</sup> Instant June /  
 Ditto Pradie run away from reaping the first of July A<sup>o</sup> 73  
 and was taken up the 17<sup>th</sup> Instant July by Brown / /  
 Ditto Pradie run away on the 9<sup>th</sup> of December A<sup>o</sup> 73 and was  
 found in the barn by Angell Kirgardsone on the 14<sup>th</sup> Instant / /  
 Ditto Pradie run away the 15<sup>th</sup> of August A<sup>o</sup> 74 and returned on  
 the 23<sup>th</sup> Instant August
