Know All men by these Presents That whereas Abraham Gording of Boston in New England mariner and Successor to Matheo Armstrong late of Boston aforesaid Mariner did constitute me Jonab Clarke of Boston aforesaid Mariner his Attorney And by his Letter of Attorney did give me full power to gett Credit and severall Debts from in Virginia or Maryland according to his said Letter of Attorney, especially from the persons under written as follows, vizt; from m^r Daniell Curtis in the County of Somerset in the Province of Maryland the quantity of fower thousand pounds of good merchantable tobacco due to the said Abraham Gording by bill, And from Stephen Bond in the same County in ditto Province of Maryland aforesaid six hundred pounds of good and merchantable tobacco and Cash due by bill And from m^r Randall Revelle of said County of Somerset in the Province of Maryland eight hundred pounds of good merchantable tobacco due by bill with all due Damages for non payment hereof according to engagement given by all the fore named Persons by their bills to the said Abraham Gording Successor to the aforesaid Matheo Armstrong And since by evidence it fortuned me the said Jonab Clarke to come to Pittsburg and could not get to the respective Residences of the aforesaid Debtors Therefore be it shewed unto all
