in Aplea of Debt &c;

And whereupon for said Randall by his Attorney Henry Smith
saith - that he the said William became indebted unto him the
said Randall the Just Summe or quantity of five hundred
fourty nine pounds of good sound merchantable tobacco Cash
as by A Certificate specially will appear (here in Co^{rt} produced)
signed with the hand & sealed with the Seale of him the said
William bearing date the seventeenth day of November
Annoq. Domini 1673 wherein the said William did affirm
upon himselfe and promise to pay unto y^e S^r Randall his
executors adm^r or Lawfull Attorney the said quantity of 539^l
of good sound merchantable tobacco Cash upon demand And
for the performance whereof he the said William bound himselfe
his heirs executors & adm^r But he the said William latter
regarding his promise & Assumption fraudulently and wickedly
to deceive him the said Randall of y^e S^d 539^l of tob^o & Cash
did not pay the full due to pay for same Although often he was
summed thereto by Smith his adm^r and hath demanded
of one thousand pounds of tob^o thereupon being
put back
