

Thomas of St George Day late of this County was summoned to answer  
unto Nicholas Bradford of the sd County in d Plea of Debt or

And whereupon the said Nicholas by his Attorney George Haffburth saith  
that the sd George Day became indebted unto him the sd Nicholas in  
the first summe or quantity of six hundred pounds of good sound  
merchantable tobacco and Cash as by a certain Instrument  
in Co<sup>rt</sup> produced signed with the hand & sealed with the seal of  
him the said George Day bearing date the 17<sup>th</sup> day of June 1674  
wherein the sd George Day did assume upon himselfe and promise  
to pay or cause to be paid to the said Nicholas his heirs executors  
or certain attorney the said quantity of 600<sup>li</sup> of good sound  
merchantable tobacco & Cash upon the 30<sup>th</sup> day of November next  
following the date of the sd Instrument And for the performance  
whereof he the said George Day binds himselfe his heirs  
executors and adm<sup>rs</sup> but he the said George Day & the regarding  
his promise and Assumption fraudulently intending to deceive  
him the said Nicholas of the sd 600<sup>li</sup> of tobacco & Cash doth not  
dote to pay the same although often herunto required the  
pe<sup>rs</sup> saith he is damnified and hath dammage to the  
value of one thousand two hundred pounds of tobacco  
and Cash and thereupon brings his Suit as follows
