Sommerf<sup>t</sup> & George Day was attested to answ<sup>r</sup> to S<sup>r</sup> of Henry  
Smith in an action of debt, / n. n. n.  
And the said Henry for himselfe saith that the said George became  
indebted unto<sup>y</sup> said Henry the summe of eighteen hundred pounds  
of tobacco & Caffe as<sup>f</sup> his specially more plainly may appear,  
but the said George fraudulently intending refusing to pay the aforesaid  
summe of 1800<sup>£</sup> tobacco & Caffe although he went several times unto  
him demanded where by he said Henry is Damified & Rate Damaged  
to<sup>y</sup> value of 3000<sup>£</sup> tobacco & Caffe & thereupon brings his suit, /  
Opp<sup>r</sup>d Henry Smith
