that he the said John became indebted unto her late husband George Parker
whereof in the first summe of Two thousand pounds of good sound moneys
stantable tobaco and Cashe as by certaine writing will appere Remem-
bered signed with the hand of him the said John Anderson bearing
date the 21th day of October Anno Domini one thousand six hundred &
sixty eight. And Assumed upon himselfe and promise to pay unto the
said George Parker his heirs exors or assigns the said quantitie
of Tobaco aforesaid vizt one thousand pounds of tobaco the same yeare
And the other one thousand pounds of tobaco the yeare after the date of
the said writing in Peromele river and for the performance whereof
bindes himselfe his heirs and exors. But he the said John
regarding his promise and Assumption but fraudulently intending
to deceave her the said Florence of the said Two thousand pounds
of Tobaco and Cashe Demitteth and still doth to pay the same Although
often demanded the sd Saith she is damaged and hath Damadge
to the value of three thousand pounds of Tobaco And hereupon
bringe his suite &c
