 summe or quantity of 336<sup>l</sup> Tobacco & Cashe. Although severall times  
 hath bin demanded whereby the said Randall is damaged & hath damage  
 (for want of the said Tobacco) to the value of six hundred & seventy pounds  
 of Tobacco & Cashe. And thereupon brings his suit
