 Margerie Stevens in dplca of Trespass upon y^e Cas^e.

And whereupon the said Margerie by her Attorney Edward
 Jones saith that he the said Thomas became indebted unto
 him the said Margerie in the full and just quantity of
 seven hundred twenty five pounds of good sound
 merchantable tobacco in Cash being due to him the said
 Margerie for severall goods and merchandises that he
 the said Thomas did take up of him the said Margerie
 at hand here produced in C^o doct more plainly appear
 for the which the said Thomas did assume upon himselfe
 and promised payment; But he the said Thomas little regarding
 his promise and Assumption fraudulently intending to deceive
 him the said Margerie of the aforesaid quantity of seven hundred
 twenty five pounds tob: due to him and still doth to paye y^e same
 although often demanded; the pt^{ie} saith he is damaged
 and hath damagede to the value of one thousand four
 hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco And
 thereupon cruieth her Bill etc; /;
