 October Annoy Domini 1674 But she the said Susanna being now
 the wife of William Gullitt fraudulently intending to deceive
 him the said David of the said right for 50 acres of land conveyed
 and still doth to procure and make good the same for the use of
 him the said David the plaintiffe saith he is dammified by
 Ratt Dammage to the value of ffortie pounds
 pounds of good sound merchantable tobacco in Cash And
 thereupon brings his suite &c /
