Summoned George Hafford Bookmaster late of this County Sheriff was summoned to answer unto Josiah Seaward in action of debt / / And whereupon by S^r Josiah for himselfe saith that he said George became indebted unto by S^r Josiah the full quantity of three hundred & fifty pounds of good fine merchantable tobacco in cash in the present year 1674 to be paid as on upon the twenty day of october last past Committed by w^{ch} payment he said Seaward himselfe his executor and adm^r as if his bill signed with his hand & sealed with the seal of him the S^r George & here in C^t produced doth more plainly appear yet the S^r Seaward upon the S^r Josiah saith he is satisfied & hath lost by value of 700^l tobacco & there upon bring his suite at / / Josias Seaward
