Sommesfett^s Robert Hignel of this County planter was summoned to answer unto George Day in a plea of Debt &c

And whereupon the said George Day for himselfe saith that the said Robert upon the 7th day of June in the year of our Lord God 1673 by bill or writing obligatory sealed with the seal of him the said Robert & Renc in Co^{rt} produced wherby it is by day & year above said did confess & acknowledge himselfe to owe and stand indebted unto the said George in the full summe or quantity of five hundred & twelvie pounds of good sound merchantable tobacco & Cashe to be paid at the dwelling house of the said Robert at or upon the 10th day of October next ensuing the date of the said bill to the said Robert himselfe his heirs & assigns &c and yet the said Robert the said Daniell of 62^l of tobacco to him the said George according to his said bill though after the same demanded hath not paid or satisfied but the same to pay or satisfy hath refused & refused & still doth deny & refuse to pay the same to the great damage of the said George whereupon he saith he is by work & rate lost to the value of 1212^l of tobacco & thereupon bringe his suite &c
