Somerset County sh<sup>d</sup> John Squier late of this County was summoned to ans<sup>w</sup> into Randall Revell in a plea of Debt &  
there are pledged to prosecute John Doe & Rich: Roe.

And whereupon the said Randall by Thomas Poole his attorney complaineth that whereas the said def<sup>t</sup> Coll<sup>or</sup> W<sup>m</sup> Colbourne  
the 15<sup>th</sup> of March 1675 by his certain bill in writing sealed with his Seal & here in Co<sup>ty</sup> produced did binde himself  
his heirs executors or assigns to pay unto the said p<sup>l</sup>t or his order a just & full quantity of four hundred & fifty  
pounds of good sound merchantable Tobacco & Caske to be paid in some Court meet place in the said County of  
Somerset at or before the tenth day of October next ensuing the date of the said bill And the said p<sup>l</sup>t in fact saith that the  
def<sup>t</sup> did not pay to the said p<sup>l</sup>t the said quantity of Tobacco at some Court meet place in the County aforesaid or else where  
either before the tenth day of October next ensuing the date of the said bill nor since hath paid the sum of the said quantity  
of four hundred & fifty pounds of Tobacco & Caske being still due & owing to the said p<sup>l</sup>t by the said def<sup>t</sup> which the  
plaintiffe to pay by the def<sup>t</sup> although often times by the p<sup>l</sup>t demanded to pay the def<sup>t</sup> is come to the p<sup>l</sup>t to pay
