& appeares neither by himselfe nor attorney: And Capt^e W^m Colebourne Sherife of this County
made appeare that the des^t was gon or upon going over the bay with drunaway -
where by the said John if he had not gon would have come to damage; And there upon
this Co^{rt} ord^{rs} the hearing of this cause the next County Co^{rt}
