A pleà of debt:

And whereas upon vs: Said Robert Catlin by his attorney Thomas Poole saith y^e he y^e said Cornelius Verhoofe
indebted unto him y^e Said Robert is just summe or quantity of six hundred & thirtie pounds of good sound
tobacco to bate w^tth C^o of 1st a certain writing here in C^o: produced more plainly w^tth appa-
rely signed w^tth y^e hand & sealed w^tth y^e seal of him y^e Said Cornelius Verhoofe bearing date y^e Eleventh
day of March Anno^r Domini 1674 wherein y^e said Cornelius did assume upon himself & premises
to pay or cause to bee paid unto vs: Said Robert or his heirs adm^rs or assignes for a valuable Consideration
in hand Recd y^e 8^d quantity of 630 of Tob: with C^o of 1st a tenth day of Oct: next ensuing
y^e date of y^e 8^d writing conveniently in Potowmke or Amansesay for y^e true performance thereof
bindes himself & his heirs adm^rs or assignes: but her y^e 8^d Cornelius fraudulently intending to defir-
him y^e Said Robert of y^e aforesd quantity of 630 of Tob: with C^o of 1st still dote to pay the
same although often remonstrance required y^e pl^t Saith her is defirred & hath damage to y^e value
of two thousand pounds of Tobacco w^tth which upon brings his suit. I. Agnes: Poole vs:
This bill bindeth me Cornelius Verhoofe Carpenter of Somersell County in y^e province of Maryland me my
heirs adm^rs or assignes to pay or cause to bee paid unto Robert Catlin planter of y^e same County & province
above said him & his heirs administrators or assignes y^e full & just quantity of six hundred & thirtie pounds of good
sound mercantable Tobacco w^tth C^o of 1st being for y^e use of Alexander Molestim for a valuable Consideration
already in hand received to containe y^e same by y^e tenth of November next ensuing after y^e date hereof conveniently
in Potowmke or Amansesay or therabouts w^tth which upon binds him & sealed this 13th day of March A^r 1674.

And y^e said Robert by his Attorney Thomas Poole further saith that y^e debt is all y^e where left y^e scarriff having
made a returne of y^e writt in: cft: in y^e summe of eight hundred pounds of Tob: in C^o of 1st a certain writing
under y^e aforesd debts hand & sealed bearing date y^e fourth day of December in y^e year 1674: whereto writing
was leave here in Court: but y^e aforesd Dale little regarding his promise & assumption but fraudulently intend-
ing him to defirre in y^e summe of eight hundred pounds of Tobacco w^tth C^o of 1st although often remonstrance required
whereupon y^e said Revell Saith her is defirred & hath damage to y^e value of y^e summe of eight hundred
pounds of Tobacco whereupon brings his suit:

And this day to witt y^e 18th of April 1676: y^e debt odaviddale by his attorney Thomas Poole Comde before
y^e Court: And y^e said Thomas Poole attw^tnowledgeth & confesseth judgement for y^e in y^e behalfe of y^e said David Dale
for eight hundred pounds of Tobacco being due to y^e pl^t: whereupon y^e Court orders y^e the debt odavid Dale pay
unto Randall Revell or his order eight hundred pounds of Tobacco & cost of suit: alias executio: 1:

The same day Comde as aforesd:

Whereas George Barnes Servant to Mr Charles Ballard of this County gentl was brought before y^e Court this day
to have his age judged the said George Barnes coming into this province without indentures & brought before
y^e Court within y^e time limited by act of Assembly in such case made after a full view had and taken
y^e said Justice of y^e said Court they are adjudged y^e said Servant George Barnes to bee fourteen years
of age and no more.
