Whereupon y<sup>e</sup> said Charles Ballard by his attorney Edward Jones saith y<sup>e</sup> y<sup>e</sup> aforesaid William about y<sup>e</sup> month of Julij last past in y<sup>e</sup> year one thousand six hundred seventij became indebted unto y<sup>e</sup> aforesaid Ballard in y<sup>e</sup> sum<sup>m</sup> of forty & two pounds of p<sup>o</sup>rk as doth appear by attempt which att<sup>r</sup> we have here to produce in Co<sup>rt</sup>: whereupon y<sup>e</sup> said William did promise & assume upon himselfe to pay unto y<sup>e</sup> aforesaid Ballard y<sup>e</sup> sum<sup>m</sup> of forty two pounds of p<sup>o</sup>rk when therunto required but y<sup>e</sup> aforesaid William little regarding his promise but fraudulently intending him to deceive in y<sup>e</sup> sum<sup>m</sup> of forty & two pounds of p<sup>o</sup>rk whereupon y<sup>e</sup> said Ballard saith hee is damnified & has damage to y<sup>e</sup> value & loss of eightij four pounds of p<sup>o</sup>rk whereupon hee brings his suit

And whereupon y<sup>e</sup> said W<sup>m</sup>: by his attorney Tho: Poole saith y<sup>e</sup> hee y<sup>e</sup> said Robert became indebted unto him y<sup>e</sup> aforesaid Greene in y<sup>e</sup> sum<sup>m</sup> of one thousand pounds of tobacco as doth appear p<sup>o</sup> bill in his hand & seal bearing date y<sup>e</sup> 14<sup>th</sup> day of Jan<sup>y</sup>: 1674: wherein y<sup>e</sup> aforesaid Rob<sup>t</sup>: did assume upon himselfe & bind himselfe his heirs exors<sup>es</sup>, or adm<sup>rs</sup>: to pay or cause to be paid unto y<sup>e</sup> aforesaid Greene of y<sup>e</sup> County & province aforesaid to him his heirs or assigns y<sup>e</sup> aforesaid 1000 of tobacco & lasq<sup>s</sup> which bill we have in Co<sup>rt</sup>: to produce but y<sup>e</sup> aforesaid Robert his promise & assumption little regarding his fraudulently intending him to deceive of 1000 of tobacco
