This Bill bindeth the Jarman Gillett of Dorsetshire in the County of Dorset plantor me my heires executors adm^r or assignes to satisfie & pay or cause to be satisfied & paid unto W^m Greene of Dorsetshire aforesaid in the County of Sommersett & Province of Maryland plantor the full & just summe of four hundred & seventie pounde of good sound merchantable Tobaco with Coste to Containe y^e same it being due to the said W^m Greene for valuable Consideration w^{ch} the aforesaid Gillett haire in hand asforesaid: The aforesaid summe of Tobaco to be paid unto the said William Greene or his heires or assignes in at or upon the tenth day of October next ensuing y^e day of the date hereof at the dwelling house of the aforesaid Jarman Gillett as witness my hand & seal the 26th day of May 1675

Maryland s^t: George Theobald of this County was summoned to answe^r unto Robt Blades in a plea of the case upon y^e case whereupon the aforesaid Robert Blades by his Attorney Edward Jones saith that the aforesaid George Theobald about the month of September in the year of our Lord God 1675 then became indebted unto the aforesaid Robert Blades in the summe of two thousand pounde of Tobaco in Cost to be paid unto the said Robert when therunto required as doth appear by Evidence here in C^o produced but the said George sith regarding his promise but fraudulently intending refuse to pay the summe of 2000^l of tob: Cost although often therunto required whereupon the p^{te} saith he is damnified and hath damage to y^e value & Cost of two thousand nine hundred pounde of Tobaco & whereupon bringe his suite at

Know All men by these presents That I Robert Blades doe oblige my selfe my heires executors adm^r or assignes to make over or cause to be made over by way of conveyance y^e plantation wherein I now live onely some young apple trees excepted unto William Gillett or his assignes for ever with all the premises therunto belonging from me my heires or assignes, & doe oblige my selfe my heires executors & adm^r to warrant the sale of the said Land against All unjust Claimes whatsoever as witness my hand & seal the 25th day of September 1673
