

Paid of him the said German Gillett bearing date y^e 26th day of May in the year of our Lord God 1675 by which writing the said German Gillett bounde upon himselfe & promise to pay or cause to be paid unto the said William after upon the tenth day of October next ensuing the date of the aforesaid writing conveniently in Sommersett County unto the said Willm Greene his Servt & exentor or adm^r to satisfie & pay 470^l of tobacco upon each in all with the aforesaid summe of 550^l of tobacco but the said German Gillett fraudulently intending to defraud the said William of the said tobacco delayng & still debt to pay the same altho often demanded - required: This pl^t witness his is Damned & hath damage to y^e value of three hundred pounds of tobacco & thereupon bringeth his suit at opposed side below

This Bill bindeth the German Gillett of Portsmode in the County of Gloucester planter me my heires & executors or assigns to satisfie & pay or cause to be satisfie & paid unto Mr. Greene of Portsmode before the County of Sommersett & Province of Maryland planter the full & just summe of five hundred & leaventy pounds of good sound merchantable tobacco with cost to satisfie y^e same at 10^d per pound to the said Mr. Greene for valuable Consideration w^t the aforesaid German Gillett handes over to the aforesaid summe of tobacco to be paid unto the said William Greene or his heires or assigns in law upon the tenth day of October next ensuing y^e day of the date hereof at the dwelling house of the aforesaid German Gillett as witness my hand & seal this 26th day of May 1675

Mar^r 25th A^m George Thibaut of this County was summond to answer unto Robt Bladis in a plac^c of his selfe upon y^e sa^d Robt Bladis by his Attorney Edward Jones saith that he aforesaid George Thibaut about the Month of Septemb^r in this year of our Lord god 1675 then became bounde unto the aforesaid Robt Bladis in the summe of two thousand pounds of tobacco in cost to be paid unto the said Robt Bladis therunto required as dotti appears by Evidente here in C^o & d^r but the said George Thibaut regarding his promise but fraudulently intending refusale to pay the summe of 2000^l of tobacco altho often here unto required to him upon the pl^t Bladis he is Damned and hath damage to y^e value & cost of two thousand nine hundred pounds of tobacco & whereupon bringeth his suit opposed side below

Know all men by these presents that Robert Bladis doe oblige my selfe my heires & executors adm^r or assigns to make over or cause to be made over by way of conveyance y^e plantation whereto I now live onely som^r Young app^{le} tree excepted unto William Gillett or his assigns for ever with all the premises therunto belonging from me my heires or assigns & do oblige my selfe my heires & executors & adm^r to warrant the sale of the said Land against all iniust clamors & calumnies whatsoever as witness my hand & seal this 25th day of September 1673
