Whereas Peter Whipple & Thomas Willis were summoned to answer unto y^e Pariahawkin Indians for taking away beanes & pease from them they appear before us & acknowledge their fault by Indians desiring rather double y^e quantitie of beanes & pease to bee delivered them back for their satisfaction then corporall punishment: Thereupon this Court orders y^e said Peter Whipple and Thomas Willis pay & carry to y^e said Indians double y^e quantitie of beanes & pease they took from them and not to bee released from their servitudes untill performed:
