y^e poore petitioner hath received of Conclius Johnson & Sother by in great danger of perishing through poverty
unless y^e wor^{sh}pp^t Chariti^e shall take care of him y^e humble petition^r hath beene all this time at Conclius
Johnson at great manij & Conclius Johnson hath paid away two h^{dr} of Tobacco to y^e doctor for y^e y^e other
wise y^e petition^r had perished before now these things y^e poore humble petitioner shall humbly crave
of y^e wor^{sh}pp^t to take itt into y^e wise Charitable Consideration in soe doing y^e poore humble petitioner
will be bound to pray: /:

To all Christian people to whom these presents shall come knowe yee y^e I: George Lane of Somers^{et}
Countie in y^e province of Maryland planter doe for many Causes & Considerations mee therunto moving give
graunt make over & confirme; and by these presents doe give graunt make over & confirme unto Alice Hall y^e
younger y^e daughter of Charles & Alice Hall of this Countie of Somers^{et} one two yearc old Starke heifer with
a white Star in her forehead & the end of her taile white & white bellij commonly knowne or called by the
name of quift marked as followeth Cropt of y^e left ear & one slit in y^e top with a nub underneath y^e Starke
the right ear one slit with the said heifer & her female increase to her y^e said Alice Hall y^e younger for y^e
 terme of ten years and then to have & to hold the said heifer & her female increase and afterwards both
male & female as her proper goods for ever to y^e only proper use & behoofe of y^e said Alice Hall y^e younger her
heirs or assigned this heifer with her increase to runn with y^e Starke of y^e said Charles Hall untill y^e said Alice
attaineth to y^e age of fourteene years for y^e use of y^e said Alice and that if y^e female increase should come
to manij itt shall be at y^e pleasure of y^e said Charles Hall her father or her guardian or guardians to convert
them to other use for y^e good & benefit of y^e said Alice as hee or they shall thinke convenient the said Alice
not to dispose of y^e said heifer or any of her female increase untill shee cometh to y^e age of fourteene years
without y^e consent of her father or guardian or guardians and in case y^e said Alice should be taken away by
death before shee cometh to y^e age of fourteene years then y^e said heifer & increase aforesaid to be y^e absolute
proper parte of y^e youngest Child either Son or daughter then living of y^e said Charles & Alice Hall at y^e
time of y^e decease of y^e said Alice Hall y^e younger: In Confirmation & full assurance of y^e truth above written
