 Charles the first and in ij year of our Lord God 1673: Bought had & received of ij said Edmund severall goods  
 wares & merchandizes amounting to ij sum of six hundred twenty & six pounds of Tobacco a partim  
 whereof is here in Court brought which said sum of six hundred twenty & six pounds of Tobacco  
 sum upon ij said Robert upon himselfe did assume & to the said Edmund did faithfully promise to  
 pay ij said Robert ij said sum of six hundred twenty & six pounds of Tobacco to him ij said Edmund  
 would well & truly pay when therunto required notwithstanding which ij said Robert his promise  
 & assumption little regarding but fraudulently intending him ij said Edmund of ij said six hundred  
 twenty & six pounds of Tobacco to receive though often therunto required hath not paid but ij sum  
 to pay hath still refused whereupon ij said Edmund saith ij hee is damaged & shall lose to ij value  
 of twelve hundred pounds of Tobacco & therupon bringeth his suite: / . . . . .
