Somerset ff: John Anderson of this County Sawyer was summoned to answer unto Majo: John West of an account in an action of Debt:

And whereupon ii said West by his Attorney Thomas Poole saith: hee the said John became indebted unto him ii said West ii summe or quantity of fiftene hundred good sufficient well rived clapboards & also to deliver ii said West as aforesaid his Skallops full load of good Cypress quarters fit to make good covering (Plates) of five foot four inches long as will more plainly appeare in Court: by a certain weightling under ii hand of him ii aforesaid Anderson wherein hee bindes himselfe his heires exors & adm^rs to deliver ii boards & timber as aforesaid which weightling beares date ii second day of March in ii year of our Lord God 1671: which wee have here in Court to produce but hee ii said John Little regarding his promise & assumption fraudulently intending him ii aforesaid West to receive of ii aforesaid boards & timber aforesaid for some and still doth deny to pay ii said timber & the plaintiffe saith hee is damaged & hath dammage to ii value of two thousand seven hundred pounds of Tobacco & thereupon brings his suit

This Bill bindeth mee John Anderson my heires exors & adm^rs to deliver unto John West his heires or assignes on all demands at my now dwelling house in Potomack river & at my landing fiftene hundred good sufficient well rived Cypress clapboards & are to be fit for covering five foot four inches long and also to deliver to ii said West as aforesaid his Skallops full load of good Cypress quarters fit to make good covering (Plapboards) of ii same length aforesaid & in consideration of ii performance of ii promises aforesaid ii said West is to allow & pay mee ii summe of eleven hundred pounds of Tobacco & Cost acknowledging by these presents to have received in goods at this instant in part of payment aforesaid ii summe of nine hundred forty three pounds of Tobacco & upon ii performance aforesaid there rest due to mee remains of ii full payment ii summe of one hundred fifty seven pounds of Tobacco & Cost to ii performance of which I binde myselfe my heires exors & adm^rs to performe ii promises aforesaid witness my hand this 2^d of March 1671: John Anderson
