Whereas there was attached by y^e Sheriff in y^e hands of Alexander Draper nine hundred forty five pounds of Tobacco of Cornelius Verhoofe to answer unto Rob^t: Catlin Sen^r in a plea of Debt & after y^e returne made It was ordered y^e the same should bee delivered to y^e said Robert Catlin which was not performed & the said Alexander appearing this day before y^e C^ort: and saith y^e there is not more due to y^e said Cornelius Verhoofe in his hands then three hundred pounds of Tobacco & the C^ort orders y^e execution bee laid upon y^e said Alexander hundred pounds of Tobacco in y^e hands of Alexander Draper belonging to Cornelius Verhoofe & the same deliver to Robert Catlin Sen^r or his order: /: a . . .

Whereas Complaint hath this day bene made to mee y^e Ambrose Dixon of y^e County of Som^o: set planter did in or neare about y^e month of February last past att y^e Tobacco house of this y^e said Dixon upon his plantation alter y^e make & dispose of five h^o: of Tobacco which was by will^m: Stevens under Sheriff to Capt Thomas Walker of y^e S^o: County marked with y^e broad arrow & intended to bee weighed & received of this y^e said Dixon towards defrauding of his publick dues & his Hon^o: Justices rents And that when y^e said William Stevens did accordingly goe about to weigh y^e same & to take an exact account thereof both for his owne satisfaction & for y^e satisfaction of this y^e said Dixon that then y^e said Dixon (in contempt of y^e power and authority to him y^e said Stevens given & in contempt of y^e lawes of y^e R^o: Hon^o: G^o: Lord Prop^r: of this province did openly & violently by force & armes & divers threatening & abusive speeches withstand and oppose y^e said Under Sheriff & would not suffer him to execute his office but disposed of y^e said Tobacco as aforesaid If therefore the said Dixon shall not att y^e next County C^ort: to bee held in y^e S^o: County repaire to y^e said C^ort: & therefore before y^e Comm^o: of y^e same openly & in publick view of y^e whole C^ort: prostrate himself upon his knees & acknowledge his great error to his Hon^o: Justices & Lord Prop^r: & in some reasonable manner crave pardon & forgiveness for y^e same promising amendment for y^e same for y^e future then you are strictly willed & required to have y^e body of this y^e said Dixon att y^e next Fall C^ort: to bee held att St: Maries on y^e nineteenth day of June next then & there before his Hon^o: Justices of y^e said C^ort: to answer such his contempt & suffer such condigne punishment for y^e same as his said Hon^o: Justices shall thinke fitt to inflict upon him: This warrant you are to cause to bee recorded in yo^r County C^ort: and in case you are forced to bring y^e body of y^e said Dixon to y^e next Fall C^ort: as aforesaid according to y^e tenours of this warrant that then ye make returne hereof att y^e S^o: C^ort: Given under my hand & Seale y^e one & twentieth day of May in y^e second year of his said Hon^o: Justices Dominion & Annap^o: Domini 1677: Tho: Norlij: Seale: /: a . . .
