Somerset County Es<sup>r</sup> William Mason late of this County was attayred to answ<sup>r</sup> unto Robert King Marquardt  
in an action of the case upon dat<sup>t</sup>, /

And wherepon the pl<sup>t</sup> by Thomas Poole his attorney comes and saies that he the said Mason in the year  
of o<sup>r</sup> Lord 1602 became indebted unto pl<sup>t</sup> the full & just summe of thre thousand one hundred  
& five pounds of Tobano & Cash to containe y<sup>e</sup> same as being due to the pl<sup>t</sup> for severall good &  
marke indizes delivered by the pl<sup>t</sup> unto the def<sup>t</sup> ab<sup>t</sup> & another in so<sup>r</sup> produced will more plainly  
appere the which An<sup>r</sup> the def<sup>t</sup> did faithfully promise to pay and satisfie unto the pl<sup>t</sup> when  
therevnto required but he the said Mason falle regarding the promise but fraudulently n<sup>t</sup> done  
the pl<sup>t</sup> to determine of the summe aforesaid of 3000<sup>r</sup> of Tobano dñe & still do<sup>r</sup> dwyng to pay  
the same although often hervnto required by the pl<sup>t</sup> wherupon he pl<sup>t</sup> saies he is Damisfied  
& hath damage to the value of 500<sup>r</sup> of tobacco & the reupon bring<sup>r</sup> this date,

& defensed by said W<sup>m</sup> Mason from the said Daniell Browne

Memorandum<sup>r</sup> at the C<sup>t</sup> o<sup>r</sup> the 13<sup>th</sup> day of November in which the C<sup>t</sup> was held  
the Clerk published two booke of matrimony three times between John Barnes  
& Alice Taylour booke of his County after betwix them Lali & Mary Cook booke
