the purchase of tobacco for the fine of Elizabeth Darnley due to be paid by John Blolter as
generally he performed in works of his said Capt^o John Blunden service to the said County
That the said County by promise made into their consideration doe order that there be paid this present
year out of the County Treasury to Capt^o Henry Smith or his order Twelve thousand pounds of tobacco
as above that John Blolter as security for Elizabeth Darnley pay unto the said Capt^o Henry
Smith five hundred pounds of tobacco The said Capt^o Henry Smith to finish the house to be
finished in four house well planted above as above before with good & substantiall floor
in both the lower rooms the upper rooms to be divided into two the outer most door of the house
with hinges & lock and keye stained glass windowes tapestrie furniture & furniture work Bar
seats for Justice pinacles Tables & all other necessaries to be compleating of the said house
