It is agreed betweene John Freeman & his Brother Joseph Freeman that the said Joseph Freeman shall paye to the said John Freeman his wife to paye out what monney she may or shall due to him in any commodity or to get seruants or what else may be thought fitt & what other business that is needfull to be done for the good of the said John Freeman his wife for his Sabour & care the said John Freeman his wife is to paye the said Joseph Freeman Twenty poundes sterling monney and what seruants are shipt if there be not above six the three is to be equal sharke of charges but if above thurtye said John Freeman is to be two parts of the charges & to haue two care his brot^{er} care and further the said John is to paye his passage in and out & what other occasions y^e need shall require in this part w^{ch} he herunto sett our hand the twentieth one day of December 1671
